What is Create your own GIFs using Adobe Illustartor & Adobe After Effects

Creating GIFs using Adobe Illustrator and Adobe After Effects is a powerful combination that allows for more dynamic animations compared to static images. Here's a step-by-step guide on how to create your own GIFs using these two software programs:

Using Adobe Illustrator:

- **Open Adobe Illustrator:** Launch Illustrator on your computer.
- **Create a New Document:** Go to "File" > "New" to create a new document with the desired dimensions and settings. Make sure to set the color mode to RGB if you intend to create a colorful GIF.
- **Design Your Graphics:** Create the elements you want to include in your GIF using Illustrator's drawing tools, shapes, text, and other features. These will serve as the assets for your animation.
- **Export Individual Assets:** Once your graphics are ready, export each element as a separate image file (e.g., PNG or JPEG). Ensure that each asset has a transparent background if needed.
